

Items you **CANNOT** put in a Roll-Off Container

This covers most Companies providing the service.

Here is the list of things you cannot put in a RecycleGuy Dumpster. The reason why is that where we haul to we have signed agreements with the final disposal companies stating we will not allow our customers to put these items in the dumpster. At the end of the article we will give you a person to contact if you do have these items and you use the RecycleGuy Roll-Off Container Service to help you, if you use our competitors please don't call us.



1. **Tires**, (truck, auto, bicycle, any tire that contained air – a pneumatic tire). Whole bicycles are allowed
2. Oil based **paints** or vanishes if they are still in liquid phase. Dried up paints or materials where kitty litter or sawdust has been added to dry up the liquid **are allowable**.
3. **Hazardous Waste** such as **herbicide poisons, acids**, or any powder that when mixed with liquid or water creates dangerous and toxic fumes. **Household Batteries or any type of battery**.
4. **Refrigerators, Air Conditions** or any appliance which has had Freon in it. You must have a certified technician remove the Freon. Old Refrigerator motors are not acceptable because they have PCB's in them that also must be removed by a licensed certified technician who will then give you proper paperwork stating the appliance is acceptable for recycling.
5. **Railroad Ties** and **Telephone Poles** are not allowed in any form.
6. **Oils of any type**.
7. **Propane Tanks** are not allowed they are considered Hazardous Waste and must be only taken to handlers of Hazardous Waste items.
8. **Television Sets and Computer Monitors** are no longer allowed to be landfilled in Indiana they must be returned through the E-Scrap portion of your local Solid Waste District.
9. **Yard waste, Christmas Trees** are not wanted at Transfer Stations, they are to be disposed of at licensed Compost Centers.
10. **Aerosol Cans** not emptied and punctured.
11. **Fluorescent Lamp Bulbs under Universal Waste Rules**
12. **No Dirt, Concrete and Rocks** unless you are prepared to have your Bill for your Container provider multiplied several fold. Disposal costs are depended on weight and a ton of heavy rocks can add \$75/ton to your bill.
